In His infinite wisdom and kindness, the Lord Jesus commands us to come to the Lord's Table with regularity to partake of the bread and the vine in remembrance of Him (*Luke 22:19, 1 Cor. 11:25*). Each time we come to the table, we silently proclaim the gospel (*1 Cor. 11:26*), reminding one another of Christ crucified for our reconciliation to God (*2 Cor. 5:18*) and for the forgiveness of our sins (*Luke 22:46-27*). Halleluiah, what a Saviour! The week leading up to the Lord's Supper is an important time for self-examination (*1 Cor. 11:27-29*) so that we may come to the table prepared, with "clean hands", and partake in a manner worthy of the gospel. Let us ask the Lord to search our hearts this week, (*Psalms 139:23-24*). May He reveal sins we need to confess (*1 John 1:9, James 5:16*), relationships we need to reconcile (*Matt. 5:23-24*) and forgiveness we need to offer (*Matt. 18:21-35*). We encourage you to read a few of the verses referenced here in preparation. The Lord's Supper is truly a time of celebration and we invite all who have repented of their sins and believed in the gospel of Jesus Christ, to join us!
