# JESUS IS THE REGENERATOR

JOHN 3:1-21

### TO KNOW JESUS AS...

- † † †
- Jesus is the WORD—both the Creator and Savior
- Jesus is the LAMB—takes away the sins of the world
- Jesus is the TRANSFORMER—turning water into wine



- And Jesus cleansed the temple (and the temple of our heart too)
- Now let us look at Jesus is **REGENERATOR**—to be born again





- Many people wants a <u>second chance</u> in life (ill. a do over)
- Born again is far more than just a second chance or the forgiveness of sins—it is a **new life** and a **new creation** (John 1:4; 2 Cor. 5:17)
- Jesus desires us to have a new life—the biblical term is regeneration
- So what is born again or regeneration? Why is this important? And how does our everyday lives be different because of it?

### WHAT IS BORN AGAIN?



- Jesus is life (1:4) and can gives life to His believers (John 5:21)
- (Titus 3:5-7) a spiritual new birth from death to life (Eph. 2:1-5)
- This is a **second** birth (spiritual) apart from the first (2 Cor 5:17; Gal 6:15) one based on flesh, and the other Spirit (John 3:6)
- Clearly Jesus thought that Nicodemus should understand...why?
- The reference in v5-6 was found in Ezekiel. 36:25-27 (also read Tit. 3:5-6)
- New birth leads to a new *divine* nature (2 Peter 1:4)

## WHY MUST WE BE BORN AGAIN?



- Instead of an entirely new life in Christ, fully relying on God, we often want to work on a better version of our current self instead
- It will never work, born of the flesh will always belong to the flesh (Rom. 8:5-8) We will never find **true joy** in our old self (ill.)
- It is all based on **His love** (John 3:16) we must recognized that we do not only need a **savior**, we need a **life giver** that can give us a spiritual life in God and in His love (Rom. 8:9-17)

# HOW CAN WE HAVE THIS NEW LIFE?

- Note: There was something interesting about Nicodemus
- He came by night—wanted an uninterrupted discussion
- He called Jesus a *rabbi* and *teacher* even though it was Nicodemus that had far more education (Pharisees)
- His <u>heart</u> was ready (Matt 13:8) since he was <u>humble</u> before Christ (James 4:6)—He came because he knew he **needed** Jesus
- Can you accept that you need Jesus more than just a better self?



#### CONCLUSION

- Nicodemus honored Jesus even though he deserved more earthly honor (Sanhedrin), because he believed that Jesus is from God
- He **believed**—just like the Israelites in the wilderness (3:14; Num. 21:7-9) but not all of them...some rather die
- Moreover, many believed that they need a **savior**, but not all of them believe that they need a need <u>life in Christ</u>. Do you?
- A humble heart and trusting in Jesus is still the only way. How are you going to respond to Jesus' love for you? (Rom. 8:31-39)
